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The Kentucky Board of Podiatry ("the Board"), and Larry Ketcherside, DPM being fully informed and advised, recite as follows:



- (1) Larry Ketcherside is a podiatrist licensed by the Board of Podiatry under KRS Chapter 311 with License Number 00358.
- (2) Pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statutes ("KRS") Chapter 311, the Board is authorized to regulate and to control all matters related to podiatry not delegated to another agency of the Commonwealth, and this matter has not been delegated to another agency of the Commonwealth.
- (3) Dr. Ketcherside failed to secure and safeguard all prescription blanks to prevent illegal use. Dr. Ketcherside agrees to the resolution of this matter by entering into this agreement.
- (4) Following a review by the Board of the facts and circumstances associated with this matter, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND ORDERED:
  - (a) Dr. Ketcherside shall pay a fine of \$500.00 to the Board.
  - (b) Dr. Ketcherside shall secure and safeguard all prescription pads and keep the pads a locked cabinet to prevent illegal use. Additionally, all prescription pads shall be numbered for tracking purposes.
  - (c) Dr. Ketcherside shall run quarterly reports, including a REVERSE KASPER to review scripts and identify fraudulent prescriptions.
  - (d) Dr. Ketcherside understands that he has a right to a hearing under KRS 311.490 (1) and KRS Chapter 13B.

(5) By entering into this consent order, Dr. Ketcherside acknowledges that he was made fully and completely aware of the due process rights afforded to him under KRS Chapter 13B and that he fully understands those rights, that he knowingly and voluntarily agrees to waive those rights, and that he knowingly and voluntarily enters into this consent order.

(6) The Consent Order, when executed, shall be presented to the Board with a recommendation for approval from the Board's counsel at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following receipt of the executed Consent Order. Dr. Ketcherside understands the Board is free to accept or reject this Consent Order, and if rejected by the Board, a formal disciplinary hearing may be scheduled by the Board with proper Notice. Dr. Ketcherside agrees to waive any right he might have to challenge the impartiality of the Board to hear the case if, after review by the Board, this Consent Order is rejected.

If the Consent Order is not accepted by the Board, it shall be regarded as null and void. Any admissions made by Dr. Ketcherside shall not be regarded as evidence against him at any subsequent disciplinary hearing. Dr. Ketcherside will be free to defend himself and no inferences against him will be made from his willingness to enter into this Consent Order. The Consent Order shall not become effective until it has been approved by a majority of the Board and endorsed by a representative member of the Board.

(7) This consent order is subject to disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act.
